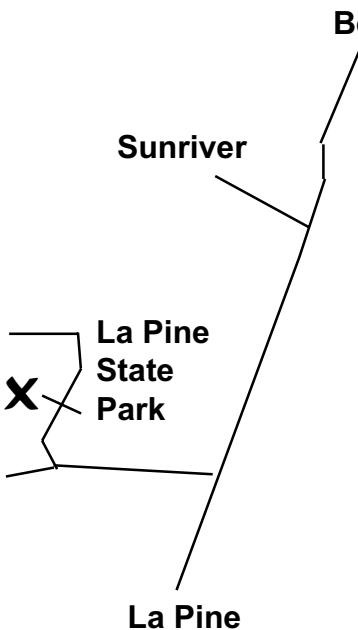
Bring : Your Scout Handbook, 10 Essentials, and your usual camp gear.

- Take Highway 97 south from Bend approximately 22 miles.
- Look for the signs indicating La Pine State Park (on west side of Hwy).
- Follow road west to "V". Follow the signs to the Day Use area, bear right. (Left is to maintenance shops).
- Look shortly for a crossroads. Turn left into the Day Use Area. (Right turns into the Big Tree / Big Pine site).
- Park in the oval parking lot. Camp area is down the hill towards the river to your immediate north.
